What information do we collect about you?

This website is used to collect and display information about chess matches played within the Bury Area Chess League. Details collected include:

- Name
- Date of Birth (for juniors)
- Chess Club Affiliation
- Chess Grade
- ECF Grading Reference
- ECF Membership Number
- Results of Games
- For League Officers, Club Officers and Team Captains we also collect contact details
 - Email Address
 - Home Address
 - Phone Number(s)

Who has access to my information?

If you participate in the league, your name, club affiliation, grade and results of games will be visible on the website to all visitors.

This information will also be shared with the East Anglian Chess Results website, and via them, with the English Chess Federation (ECF). Locations of publication therefore include, but (being in the public domain) are not limited to:

Names, club affiliation and grade is also published in print in the Bury Area Chess League Handbook (produced annually).

Contact Details for League Officers, Club Officers and Team Captains

To facilitate the running of the league, contact details of league officers are shared on the website. For promotion of the league's activities they may also be shared with ECF (for the ECF Yearbook).

Contact details of league officers, club officers and team captains are included in the printed version of the league handbook, but will be suppressed on request.

A version of this document including all contact details (with none suppressed) may be made available within the secure, password-protected area of the league website. Versions from previous years will not be available online.

Use of Contact Details

The league expects to use contact details for the following purposes.

- Email addresses used as usernames for captains' access to the website
- Email addresses used to notify league officers, club officers and team captains of league news, especially where this news may require action from those parties. Examples include
 - Notice of the league AGM and its agenda.
 - Notice of important rule changes within the league, at the ECF or at FIDE.
 - Notice of other league events, such as the Bury St Edmunds Congress or the League Rapidplay event.
- Email addresses used to notify captains of requirement to enter or confirm a match result.
- Email addresses and/or phone numbers for discussing possible rearrangement of fixtures or difficulties reaching a venue due to transport problems or dangerous driving conditions.

Cookies
